So that we can accommodate the anticipated demand, please adhere to the following length requirements: ≤ 20 double-spaced (12 pt. font) text and ≤ 8 figures/tables. In the submission process you will be asked to indicate if your paper is part of a special issue. In addition, it would be helpful if you include a copy of this letter in the “Supplementary Files” section. Finally, we will need you to adhere to the deadline.
