



ISCRE 25 Travel Grant Program for Graduate Students and Early Career Faculty

ISCRE Inc. is pleased to announce a competitive program to provide financial support for travel to ISCRE 25 to be held in Florence, Italy from May 20 to 23, 2018 (see: <http://www.aidic.it/iscre25/>). The theme of the conference is “Engineering the Chemical Transformation by Bridging Science and Technology”.

The competitive travel grant program will provide a limited number of \$1,500 grants to deserving graduate students and post docs, and \$2,000 to deserving early career faculty who will present either an accepted talk or poster at the conference. To be eligible, all applicants must be employed at a U.S. university. Early career faculty must be less than 7 years from their PhD as of Sept. 1, 2017. Applicants should send a PDF that includes a 1-page CV (NSF format) and submitted ISCRE 25 Abstract to Prof. Mike Harold (mharold@uh.edu).

The due date for applications is Oct. 20, 2017.
