The symposium banquet is on Tuesday evening from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm. The evening will begin with a reception starting at 7:15 pm in the Grande Place. After the reception, we will move into the main Ballroom for dinner.

The highlight of the banquet will be the presentation of the 2023 Neal R. Amundson award to Klavs Jensen after dinner. The organizers of ISCRE 27 will also unveil their plans for the next symposium.

Poster presenters will have time to place their poster prior to the sessions. Velcro stickers will be provided to adhere your poster. Wine, beer, and non-alcoholic beverages along with light snacks will be available during both poster sessions.

Presenters are asked to remove their posters immediately after the session. Posters that are not removed will be taken down by our symposium staff and discarded.

The ISCRE 27 organizers are providing cash awards to the top two students (including postdoctoral researchers). The poster judges will evaluate each poster presentation based on the quality of the poster, the student's verbal presentation, and the student's responses to questions about the poster. The poster awards will be announced and distributed at Wednesday morning Plenary session.

Internet Access & Check-in
